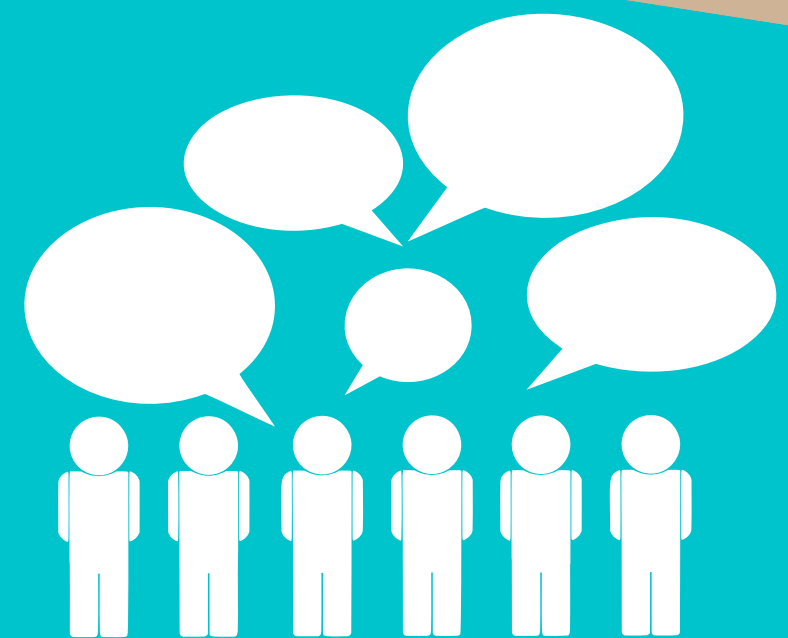
The “Recommended HIV/AIDS Strategies for Hong Kong”

The “Recommended HIV/AIDS Strategies for Hong Kong” (the Strategies) is developed by the Hong Kong Advisory Council on AIDS (ACA) every five years.

The process of its formulation adopted a wide-based approach of engaging different parties, including Community Stakeholders' Consultation Meeting and gathering the input of individuals, groups and organizations as well as the general public during the subsequent public consultation. The Strategies cover surveillance, health promotion and HIV prevention, treatment and care, and is underpinned by policy-setting and recommending programme funding priority.

Seven sessions of “Community Stakeholders' Consultation Meeting for the development of Recommended HIV/AIDS Strategies for Hong Kong” (CCM) will be conducted in July this year, jointly by the Community Forum on AIDS (CFA) and the Hong Kong Coalition of AIDS Service Organizations (HKCASO). To avoid social gathering in the time of ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the CCM will be conducted simultaneously in Red Ribbon Centre and HKCASO members' centres depending on the number of attendance. With utilization of video conferencing technology, the participants could freely discuss and voice out opinions on matters of concern to the community. The language used in CCM will be mainly Cantonese except for the session of ethnic minority.



The tentative date and targets of the seven sessions of CCM:

July 13 (Tue) noon:	Female sex worker and male client
July 13 (Tue) night :	People living with HIV
July 14 (Wed) night :	Men who have sex with men
July 15 (Thu) afternoon:	Adolescent and youth
July 16 (Fri) afternoon:	People who inject drug
July 16 (Fri) night:	Transgender people
July 18 (Sun) afternoon:	Ethnic minorities
